


# KILLIN'




It's an incredible thing to be able to recreate that for a career. It's an amazing thing and I love it!

struggle sometimes,

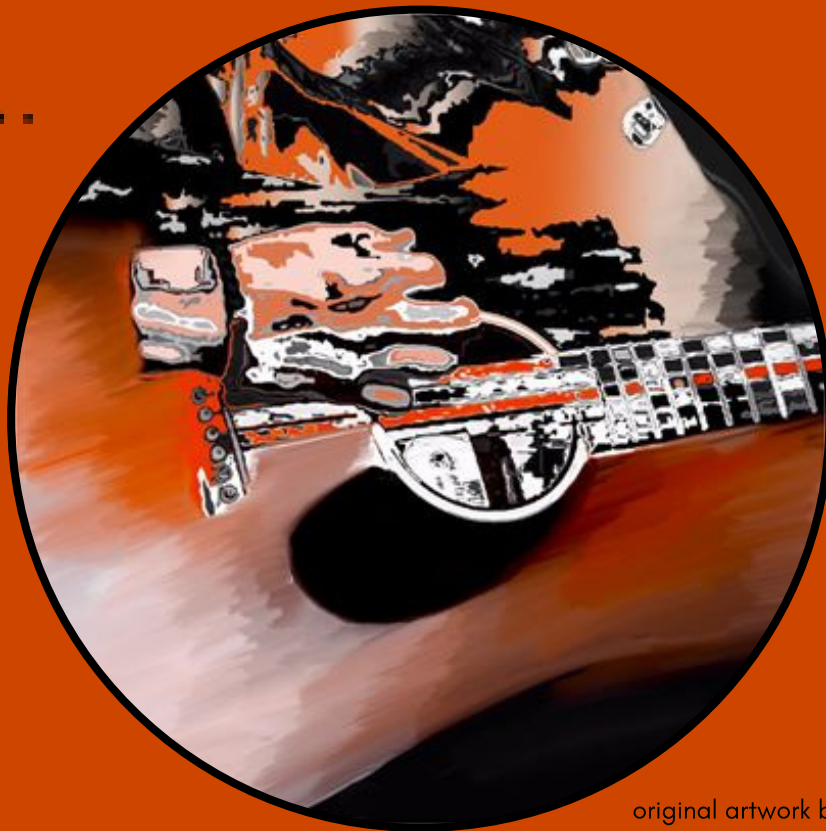
